Contributions Sought for Book on History of Memphis Legal Community by John Thomason

The Memphis Bar Association has entered into an agreement with Association Publishing Company of Birmingham, Ala., to publish a detailed illustrated history of the Memphis legal community. The book will be a hard cover consisting of approximately three hundred pages, abundantly illustrated, and will be ready for distribution in 2008.

John Thomason, retired senior partner of the Memphis firm of Thomason Hendrix Harvey Johnson & Mitchell has agreed to do the necessary historical research and write the text. With the exception of two and a half years with the Army JAG Corps in Germany, Thomason practiced law in Memphis beginning in 1952. Although he has first hand knowledge of the local legal community, he is requesting assistance in the preparation of this new history of Memphis lawyers and law firms.

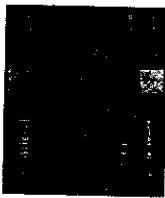
